The Commissioners of Public Works order that to ensure the safety of participants in the **Simon Home Run** event to be held on Saturday 1st October 2022, the following restrictions will apply in the Phoenix Park on the day and for the periods hereinafter mentioned:

Date of Event:

Saturday 1st October 2022

Road to be closed to vehicular traffic between 8.00 am and 1.00 pm:

Acres Road

Roads to be closed to vehicular traffic between 8.45 am and 1.00 pm:

Survey Road (between Mountjoy Cross and its junction with Furze, Knockmaroon and Upper Glen Roads)

Upper Glen Road/Glen Road (between the junction of Furze and Survey Roads to Chapelizod Gate)

Military/Corkscrew Road (between Chapelizod Gate and its junction with Wellington Road)

Roads to be closed to vehicular traffic from 10.00pm on Friday 30th Septemberto 1.00pm on Saturday 1st October:

Chesterfield Avenue from the Phoenix Roundabout to Mountjoy Roundabout

Gates to be closed to vehicular traffic between 8.45 am and 1.00 pm:

Chapelizod Gate Saturday 8.45am – 1.00pm

(Except for access to St. Mary's Hospital & Cara Cheshire Home

Ashtown Gate Saturday 8.45am – 1.00pm

(Left turn only on Entry except for access to Farmleigh House)

Knockmaroon Gate will be closed from 11.00pm on Friday 30th September to 1.00pm on Saturday 1st October.


All roads and gates will re-open as soon as it is safe to do so.
